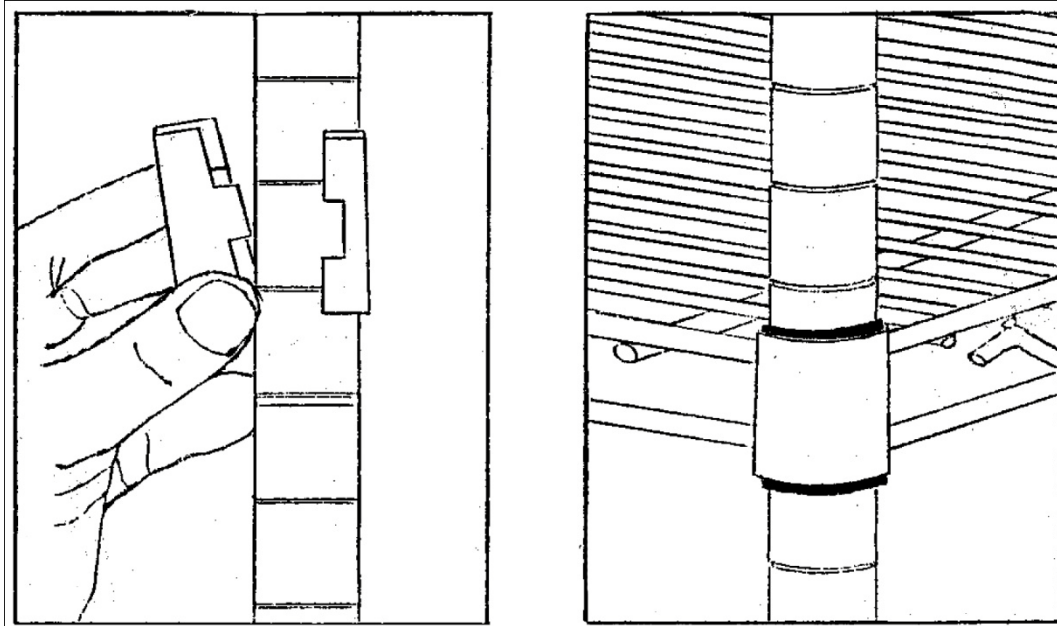

SHELVING CLIP USE INSTRUCTIONS



FREE STANDING UNIT

Note: Every eighth groove is doubled for easy assembly.

1. Determine the position of your lowest shelf. At the lowest shelf groove where the shelf will be located snap one half of the plastic slip sleeve support (with the wider part down) onto the post. (Note: Foodservice applications, NSF requires a 6" clearance from the floor) Snap the remaining half of the support clip and slide the up or down until it fits securely without moving within the grooves. Repeat for the three other posts.
2. Insert each post from the bottom of the shelf until the plastic shelf clip supports fit firmly inside the shelf holes. (This if a one person job will require setting the shelf on it's side).
3. After the last post is inserted return the unit to the upright position and gently tap down with a mallet to secure the shelf down. (Recommended to utilize a cloth between the "pounding device" or mallet, so as to not possibly destroy the finish on the shelf).
4. Continue to affix plastic slip sleeves supports and secure shelves as needed from the upright position (now), meaning that your will be placing the shelves downward on the four posts standing up (with your first secured shelf at the bottom level already in place).
